

The Crystal Ballroom is also an elegant space with its original six-foot-wide chandelier. With a star-lit ambience, 25 to 200 guests will come across designer brass chandeliers and lanterns that go along with its neutral Moroccan palette.

These luxurious rooms also come with free parking and complimentary WiFi. Full-service catering and a dedicated meeting staff is also offered so that every event runs smoothly from the set-up all the way to the tear-down. ALPINE-STYLE HOTEL IN THE HEART OF IDAHO’S SUN VALLEY ATTRACTS MEETINGS AND EVENTS


Bringing the old-world charm of a European mountain ski chalet to the

mountain wonderland of Sun Valley, the Knob Hill Inn is an all-season destination resort. The Inn’s 29 large guest rooms and suites are elegantly appointed and feature superb mountain views.
